HOW to JOIN the NEAAU GIRLS SOFTBALL LEAGUE

CREATE a NEAAU SOFTBALL CLUB

ROSTERS

- Rosters MUST be final by April 1st and faxed to 401-305-3878 or emailed to contact@neaau.org

LEAGUE SETUP

1. *AGE GROUPS* – 10U, 11/12U, 13/14U, 15U
2. *DIVISIONS* - Teams are put in Division by zip codes and skill level. Division will have no less than 5 teams and no more than 9 teams.
3. *LEAGUE PLAY* - starts March 27, 2010 (*weather permitting*) and ends June 2010. Minimum 12-14 Games
4. *LEAGUE TOURNAMENT* – June 2010 (dates and locations TBD)

SCHEDULING

1. *OPEN SCHEDULED* - NEAAU Softball has what we call **open scheduling**. Teams MUST play divisional teams twice. We suggest playing these games on Sunday on based upon field availability. Teams can play any team in their age division any time, any place and as many times as they want.

2. **DEADLINE** - Schedules will be made at the March meeting and a copy **MUST** be submitted to the NEAAU before the team leaves the meeting

FIELDS

- Each team should secure a HOME field for playing

LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

1. **DATE** – July 2010 (dates and locations TBD)
2. **QUALIFY** – 24 team maximum in each Age Division. The top 2 teams from divisions with 8 teams or more will qualify for the NEAAU Championships. Only the top team from a division with 7 or less teams will advance to League Tournament. If we need more teams to reach the number of 24 teams the tournament committee will select the at-Large teams.

***League tournament details are subject to change based on the amount of teams that sign up to participate in the 2010 NEAAU Softball League*
