HOW to JOIN the NEAAU BASEBALL LEAGUE

CREATE a NEW AAU BASEBALL CLUB (www.aausports.org)

- The NEAAU can help you form teams, find players, promote tryouts and more, but you first must register with the AAU.
- Please visit <http://aausports.org/JoinNow.aspx> to become an AAU member and register your new team. Three different club levels are available, but most NEAAU Baseball clubs are Level II.

PURCHASE INDIVIDUAL AAU MEMBERSHIP (www.aausports.org)

- All team coaches and players must be registered as AAU members before competing in the NEAAU Baseball League or any sanctioned AAU Baseball events.

INSURANCE (for Players & Coaches)

- Individual coach and player membership includes insurance
- **IMPORTANT NOTE: The Extended Benefit Membership (\$14) will cover your players no matter where they may play (AAU or OTHER).**

NEAAU BASEBALL LEAGUE FEES (www.neaa.org)

- The following info is from the 2011 NEAAU League. 2012 info will be available end of 2011
- 1-7 Teams = \$350 per team (PAY on www.neaa.org/members/register)
- 8+ Teams = \$2500 max
- Each team must post a **250.00 refundable bond**. (PAY on www.neaa.org/members/register). This bond is in used for team forfeits or league violations. If a team Forfeits they will lose their bond and must replace in 48 hours or their next game to the **full 250.00**. If a coach get ejected it's a 100.00 fine, which comes out of the teams bond. **100.00** must be replaced within **48 hours**.

ROSTERS

- Team can consist of 20 players and 4 coaches

LEAGUE SETUP

- *AGE GROUPS* – 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U, 13, 14U, Underclassmen, Upperclassmen
- *DIVISION TYPES* – Open, Super, Diamond (not all age groups have all three division types)
- *DIVISIONS* - Teams are put in Division by zip codes. Division will have maximum of 8 teams.
- *LEAGUE PLAY* – 2012 league play starts in early April
- *LEAGUE TOURNAMENTS* – See www.neaaau.org/eventsbaseball.aspx for dates.

***All new teams to NEAAU baseball will be put in the Open Division for their first season, unless baseball committee determines otherwise. Any late team entries to NEAAU baseball will be put in the Open Division*

SCHEDULING

- Below is 2011 League Scheduling info. 2012 information will be available end of 2011.
- *OPEN SCHEDULED* - NEAAU Baseball has what we call **open scheduling**. Teams MUST play divisional teams twice. We suggest playing these games on Sunday. Teams can play any team in their age division any time, any place and as many times as they want.
