#### CREATE a NEW AAU LACROSSE TEAM

- The NEAAU can help you form teams, find players, promote tryouts and more, but you first must register with the AAU
- Please visit <http://aasports.org/JoinNow.aspx> to become an AAU member and register your new team. Three different club levels are available, but most NEAAU Lacrosse clubs are Level II. Club level II allows you to host your own events.

#### PURCHASE INDIVIDUAL AAU MEMBERSHIP

- All team coaches and players must be registered as AAU members before competing in the any sanctioned AAU Lacrosse events.

## HOST YOUR OWN AAU TOURNAMENT

1. Only clubs register as Club Level II or III can sanction and host their own tournaments.
2. If you wish to host your own AAU Basketball Tournament you must sanction your event with the AAU at <https://application.aausports.org/clubapp/default.asp?M=2-3>.
3. You will need your AAU Club Code and your individual AAU Membership number to sanction a new AAU tournament.
